I am an independent medical practitioner providing general practice services at Bathurst General Practice Group. Here is a list of my frequently used fees, and I will decide on the appropriate fee at the conclusion of each consultation.

If you encounter any difficulties in paying the consultation fee, please discuss this with me directly. Payment is required on the day of service, and for your convenience, Bathurst General Practice Group is equipped with Medicare Easyclaim.

Generally, I operate on a private billing basis. However, consultations for Pensioners Veteran Affairs, Health Care Card holders, and children are offered at discounted rates. Currently, I bulk bill only for GP management plans and health assessments. I regularly review my fees, which may change based on various factors, following the guidance of AMA fees.
