I am an independent medical practitioner providing general practice services at Bathurst General Practice Group. Here is a list of my frequently used fees, and I will decide on the appropriate fee at the conclusion of each consultation.

If you encounter any difficulties in paying the consultation fee, please discuss this with me directly. Payment is required on the day of service, and for your convenience, Bathurst General Practice Group is equipped with Medicare Easyclaim.

Generally, consultations for Pensioner, Veteran Affairs, Health Care Card holders, and children under the age of 16 are bulk billed. I also bulk bill GP Management Plans and Health Assessments.

Consultations for Veteran Affairs, Health Care Card holders, and children under the age of 16 may be bulk billed. I also bulkbill GP Management Plans and Health Assessments. Saturday clinic consultations are privately billed.
