This is a list of GP Registrar frequently used fees. The GP Registrar will decide on the appropriate fee at the conclusion of each consultation.

If you encounter any difficulties in paying the consultation fee, please discuss this with the doctor directly. Payment is required on the day of service, and for your convenience, Bathurst General Practice Group is equipped with Medicare Easyclaim.

Generally, consultations for Pensioner, Veteran Affairs, Health Care Card holders, and children under the age of 16 are bulk billed. Registrars also bulkbill GP Management Plans and Health Assessments.
